Tuesday – Arrive at BEST WESTERN Le Strange Arms Hotel during the afternoon with a welcome by the hotel and your guide – Stuart White, at a reception party at 7.00pm followed by dinner in the restaurant.

Wednesday – After a hearty breakfast and with a packed lunch provided by the hotel, we will have a full day out birdwatching along the North Norfolk coast, we will then return to the hotel for dinner and a get together to discuss the day's sightings.

Thursday – After breakfast and with a packed lunch we will have another full days birdwatching along the Norfolk coast. The tour will finish at 3.30pm and those who wish to depart will head for home, otherwise a return to the hotel for a relaxing evening and an optional third night at the hotel.

Sites visited – Holkham, Cley, Titchwell, Thornham, Holme, Snettisham (dependant on tide) and other lesser known spots along the coast, the exact itinerary will depend on the weather and where the birds are.

Target birds – Geese, Birds of prey, wading birds, Barn & Short-eared Owls, Shorelark, Bearded Tits and Snow & Lapland Bunting

The holiday includes a drinks reception, 2 nights dinner bed & breakfast, a packed lunch both days, transport by mini bus and the services of "Bird tour" Guide – Stuart White plus an extra guide for larger groups.



The programme will not run unless there is a minimum of 6 participants. If numbers fail to reach the minimum, 3 weeks prior to the holiday date, the holiday reservations will be cancelled and full refunds made.
